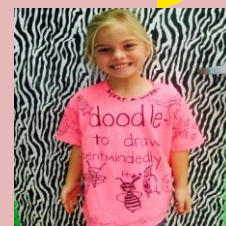

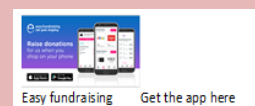
### More masters
