Among the most desperately needed supplies are:

- Nappies, wipes and children's colouring books and crayons/pencils
- Large blankets and sleeping bags
- First aid items such as plasters, bandages and antiseptic wipes/wash
- Protein bars, baby food pouches (which can't contain meat or milk due to border controls), sterilising tablets, and dry foods such as pasta, rice, tea and biscuits
- Vests and new socks and pants
- Toiletries such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, bars of soap and roll-on deodorant (no aerosols)
